Relating to access to criminal history record information by a public defender's office and the office of capital writs and to an exemption for those offices from fees imposed for processing inquiries for that information.

This bill would permit public defender's offices and the Office of Capital Writs to access criminal history record information from the Department of Public Safety at no charge. Currently if such offices access the information they must pay \$1 per electronic inquiry, \$10 per paper inquiry based on name, and \$15 per inquiry based on fingerprints. This proposal was considered and approved by the TIDC's legislative workgroup in the summer of 2012.
