County Response for Finding One:

Wharton County Action Plan:

Magistrates advise all inmates at the time of magistration of their right to counsel. I have spoken with Lieutenant Roddy Rodriguez with the Wharton County Sheriff's Office and he has informed me that at the time of magistration, the magistrate informs the inmate on camera that if the inmate needs help the Wharton County Sheriff's Office will assist them. Inmates are not leaving the holding area until the paperwork is completed. The paperwork is then sent over to the appointing court within 24 hours.

County Response for Finding Three: Wharton County Action Plan:

All requests received for misdemeanors are ruled upon promptly upon receipt by the Indigent Defense Coordinator. Most of these defendants had bonded out prior to the receipt of the paperwork.

In the past, we were not appointing counsel to those defendants who had bonded out before an indigency ruling was made. We have fixed that error in procedure. The Indigent Defense Coordinator now ignores whether or not the defendant has bonded out. The coordinator indicates a negative indigency ruling on the worksheet and sends a copy to the defendant and the prosecutor, who will have that information when the defendant appears in court. If ruled indigent, counsel is appointed immediately and the coordinator sends a copy of the appointment to the appointed counsel and to the prosecutor. We now appoint counsel to all who are determined to be indigent whether or not they have bonded out.
